Donna Mann thanked the council for their support of the festival held June 7th

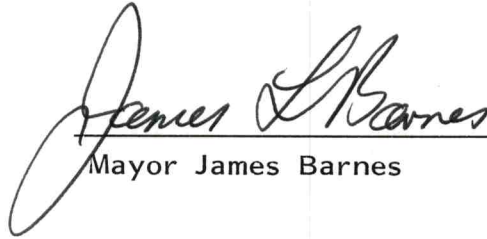
There being no further business, Commissioner Medlar moved to adjourn, seconded by Ted Suneson
