Mayor, Commissioners
Attorney Reports

Mayor Barnes: Advised that the Plan Commission suggests that Illinois Street at Route #64 on Liberty Hill be closed due to the dangerous location. The Council agreed to hold a Public Hearing June 25, 1984 at 7:30 P.M. in regard to this matter.

Commissioner Collins advised that we have been taxed for a portion of land given to the City by Conkeys for 1983. Because of the cost involved in seeking exemption for 1983 taxes, Collins advises that the City pay the \$34.00 taxes. The Council agreed.

Commissioner Svoboda advised that the water department would be flushing hydrants Thursday on the north end of town and Friday on the south side.

Bill Alden of Mt. Morris filed a complaint against the City for a fall he took while out jogging on Depot Street. Attorney Smith advised the City is not responsible for his accident.

There being no further business, Commissioner Braden moved that the meeting be adjourned. Seconded by Norman Collins.

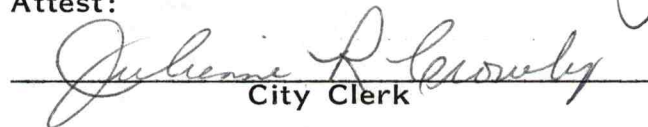
