Commissioner Jim Lauer explained that the original contract with EMC stated that someone needed to come to a council meeting to let the city know that the company was financially sound and this resolution would state that they could do this in writing. Commissioner Jim Lauer moved to pass Resolution No. 623 modification of the EMC contract, Seconded by Commissioner Gerald Medlar.

Commissioner Amy Trimble had a new quote from Municipal Code Corp. to put only certain sections of the codebook on the Internet rather than put the whole codebook. The new quote is \$1,442.00 dollars and to put the entire codebook was \$1,805.00 with the difference being \$363.00 dollars. Commissioner Amy Trimble moved to approve the quote of \$1,442.00 to put on sections 3,4,6,7,8,9,10, &11 of the codebook on the Internet, Seconded by Commissioner Gerald Medlar.

Roll Call: Lauer, Medlar, Stone, Trimble. No Nays.

Commissioner Jim Lauer handed out a map that suggested where to put the Welcome to Oregon Signs. He would like to see two of the signs be put on city property, one at the lift station at Fairgrounds Subdivision and the other on Route 64 by Lover's Lane apartments. The consensus of the council was to move forward with putting up the signs once they are done.

Commissioner Jim Lauer also explained that EMC would be having a bill for about \$8,000.00 dollars to replace valves during the storm sewer project. Bob Rees contacted Jim and said he would like to form a group to clean up and revamp the depot building. He will try to setup fundraisers to help pay for the costs.

Commissioner Tom Stone does not want South Fifth Street closed between Washington and Jefferson Street. He is concerned about the traffic flow that takes place in town now without having a street closed. Tom will be contacting the county engineer to discuss this matter.

Mayor Arians announced that Pam Blickem from Kishwaukee College will be at the July 23,2001 meeting to give us an update on the information she has for the Comprehensive Plan.
