There being no further business, Commissioner Aurand moved to adjourn. Seconded by Frank Svoboda.

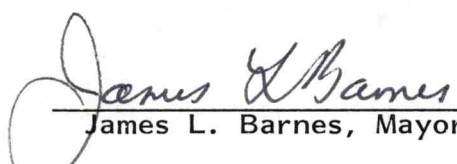
