Donna Mann addressed the Council with a request for AOP assistance from the City as in the past. The Council approved.

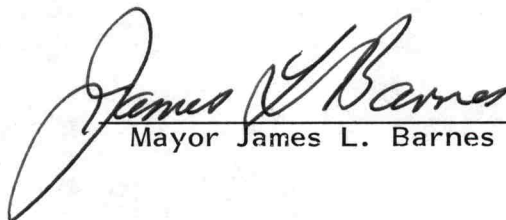

Seconded by Ted Suneson.

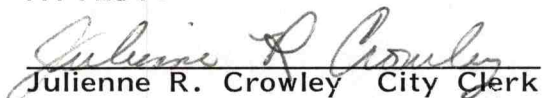
