Mayor Tom Stone reminded citizens not to blow grass clippings in the street when mowing.

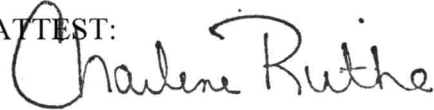
Mayor Toms Stone announced when citizens are with out electricity for any length of time, the Coliseum will be used as a cooling place.
