There being no further business, Commissioner Aurand moved to adourn, seconded by Ted Suneson.

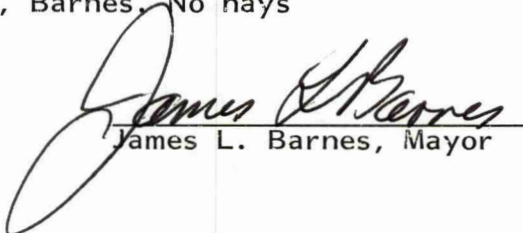
