Mayor Barnes proclaimed July 28, 1985 as "Voices To Vienna Day".

Polly Pedersen and Joanne Towne addressed the Council requesting support for Senate Bill 428, which includes \$40,000.00 toward the Oregon High School Choir's trip to Vienna. It has passed both Houses and is waiting for the Governor's signature.

They would like to hold a raffle for "Voices To Vienna" which would exceed the ordinance limit for prizes and request permission to raffle off a car. The Council advised for them to submit an application from the Oregon Booster Club with the request at the next council meeting for approval.

Engineer's Report:

1. Advised the street and sewer repair on Route #64 between Second and Third Streets would be completed Tuesday.

2. Advised the East Oregon water project connection would be completed on the west side of the river by Wednesday.

The Council discussed an accident injury report which was submitted by Kent Ross, father of Zachary Ross, who was injured at the Oregon Swim Pool. Attorney Smith advised that the city is not financially responsible for the child's injury. The child dove off the side of the pool and struck his head on the side of the pool.

Chief Miller presented the mid-year police report.

Chief Miller requested an extension until August 30, 1985 before moving back to Oregon from Byron due to house closings. The Council granted the request.

Commissioner Braden advised that Gary Robinson has not complied with his notice by letter in regard to the inoperable vehicles on his property south of Washington and First Street. Attorney Smith advised a complaint and notice to appear may be filed against him.

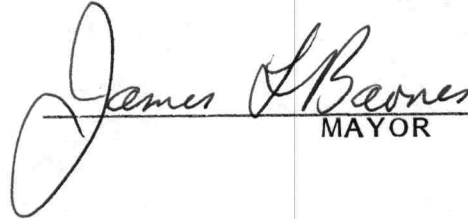
