Mayor Tom Stone asked everyone to keep Patrick and the Wiesner family in their thoughts and prayers do to the passing of his mother.

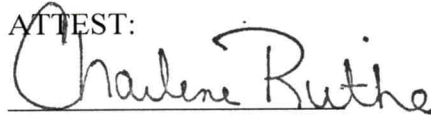

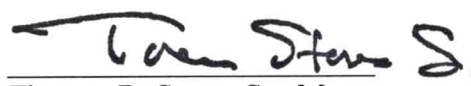
