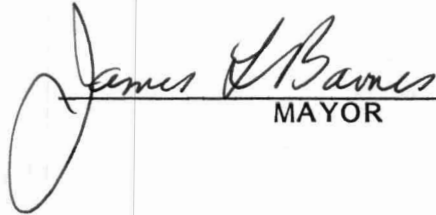

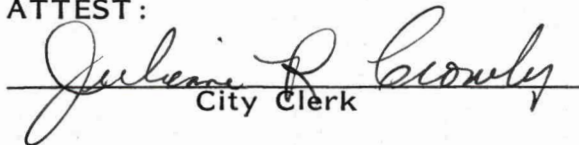
There being no further business, Commissioner Collins moved that the meeting be adjourned.
