Sylvia Newcomer complained that the chlorine in the water is too strong. Tim Hasara is going to meet with Newcomers Tuesday to test the chlorine.

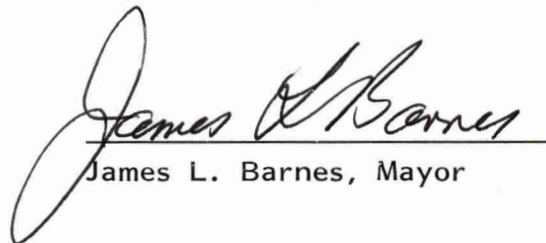

There being no further business, Commissioner Aurand moved to adjourn, seconded by Ted Suneson.

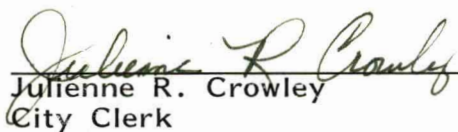
