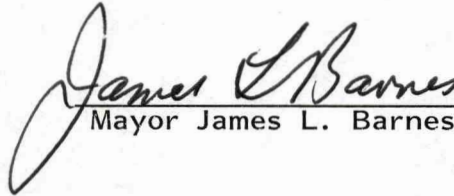
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There being no further business Commissioner Aurand moved that the meeting be adjourned.
