Donna Mann asked the Council if they would listen to the two different groups regarding the temporary liquor license ordinance before it is passed. The consensus of the Council was for them to speak before the ordinance is passed.

Donna Mann and Ron Colson spoke on behalf of the Autumn on Parade committee and task force. They have concerns about the Fire Department having a dance the weekend of the festival. It is a family oriented weekend and that image has made the festival successful. In the following years they would like AOP to hold the temporary liquor license the weekend of the festival.

Chief Garry Griffin explained to the Council what they had set up for the dance. They would have their own security, the area would be fenced in, and it would be from 8:00 P.M. until 12:00 A.M. When the date was set they did not think about it being AOP weekend.

Commissioner Tom Stone moved to pass Ordinance No. 1148 to add a Class F temporary liquor license for a not-for-profit organization, the fee will be seventy-five dollars, it will be limited to one a year, and to one organization at a time, Seconded by Commissioner Jim Lauer.
