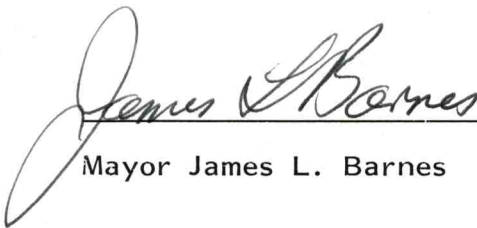
Donna Mann asked if the next newsletter could go out the middle of October. Commissioner Aurand approved.
