Tabled

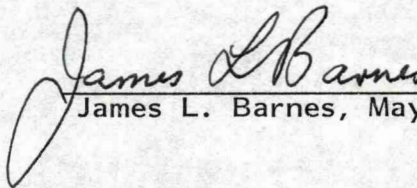

Seconded by Roger Logan.

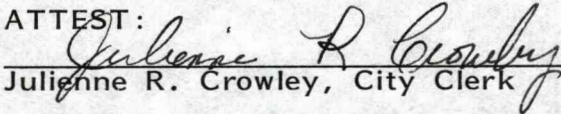
