The Council of the City of Oregon met Monday, September 12, 1983 at 7:00 P.M., City Hall Building.

Present: Commissioners Norman Collins, Elma Braden, James Ludwig, and Frank Svoboda. Absent: Mayor James Barnes.

Also present: City Clerk Julianne Crowley.

Commissioner Collins opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Commissioner Braden moved that the minutes of the August 22, 1983 meeting be approved as recorded. Seconded by Frank Svoboda.

Said motion carried on roll call as follows: Ayes: Collins, Braden, Ludwig, Svoboda. No nays.

Commissioner Collins moved that the Motor Fuel Tax Audit for the period January 1, 1982 and ending December 31, 1982 be accepted and placed on file. Seconded by James Ludwig.

Said motion carried on roll call as follows: Ayes: Collins, Braden, Ludwig, Svoboda. No nays.

Commissioner Collins moved that the application for a Class A liquor license submitted by William Capriola, D/B/A The Cafe of Conover Square, be approved and a license be issued upon the forfeiture of the license

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presently issued to Joan Reardon, D/B/A The Cafe of Conover Square, the receipt of a surety bond, lease and fee of \$400.00 for the period September 12, 1983 through April 30, 1984. Seconded by Elma Braden.

Said motion carried on roll call as follows: Ayes: Collins, Braden, Ludwig, Svoboda. No nays.

Commissioner Collins moved that Ordinance #879, entitled "Liquor" amending Chapter 5-4-7 be introduced and filed for public inspection. Seconded by Frank Svoboda.

Said motion carried on roll call as follows: Ayes: Collins, Braden, Ludwig, Svoboda. No nays.

Commissioner Collins moved to issue a permit to display fireworks at Autumn on Parade festivities. Seconded by Elma Braden.

Said motion carried on roll call as follows: Ayes: Collins, Braden, Ludwig, Svoboda. No nays.

The Council approved the Clerk's recommendation to issue the Black-hawk Twirlers a raffle license.

Several residents of the Koontz Subdivision addressed the Council to request a street light and sidewalk to be constructed along the path between Koontz Drive and the school. This walkway is used by many people for access to the school and it is a very dark area and muddy at times. Commissioner Ludwig is going to investigate and report on the request.

Bob Hood, representative of Casey's General Store on West Washington Street, requested consideration for a package beer license for their store. Commissioner Collins advised that there were no licenses available at this time and since Mayor Barnes, the liquor commissioner was absent, Collins recommended that Hood return to the Council at another time.

Dennis McMullen gave a report on various city projects.

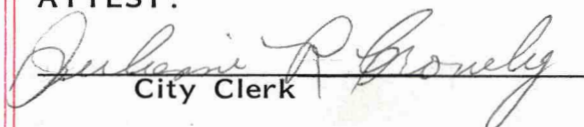

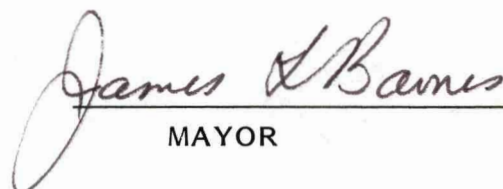
There being no further business, Commissioner Svoboda moved that the meeting be adjourned. Seconded by Elma Braden.
