Comptroller.

Audit Report

Said motion carried as follows: Ayes: Collins, Crenshaw,
Lauer, Logan, Barnes. No nays.

Commissioner Lauer moved that Ordinance #944, an
ordinance amending Chapter 9, Article 2, Section 10-26
"Stop Streets", introduced and filed for public inspection
August 24, 1987, be passed.
Seconded by Roger Logan.

Ordinance #944

Said motion carried as follows: Ayes: Collins, Crenshaw,
Lauer, Logan, Barnes. No nays.

Commissioner Lauer moved that Fifth Street, between
Washington & Jefferson Street and portions of Jefferson
Street between Third & Sixth Street be closed at various
times during Autumn on Parade festivities.
Seconded by Roger Logan.

Close Streets
Autumn on Parade

Lauer expressed a concern about the merchants in that
area being notified about the closing of the streets.
Commissioner Collins advised that the Autumn on Parade
Committee would notify the businesses of this matter.

Said motion carried as follows: Ayes: Collins, Crenshaw,
Lauer, Logan, Barnes. No nays.

Commissioner Logan moved that the Council of the City
of Oregon authorize Marshall & Stevens, Inc. to do a
complete new appraisal and valuation of the city owned
buildings and contents. He further moved that the
approximate quoted fee of \$7,400.00 be approved.
Seconded by Norman Collins.

Property Appraisal

Said motion carried as follows: Ayes: Collins, Crenshaw,
Lauer, Logan, Barnes. No nays.

Commissioner Crenshaw requested the Council to support
Representative Lynn Martin on legislation which she is
going to introduce in regard to competition for Common-
wealth Edison to allow municipalities a choice in utility
companies. Crenshaw moved that the Council support this
legislation. Commissioner Logan suggested the Council wait
to see what legislation is presented before supporting it.
Mayor Barnes and Commissioner Collins agreed. Commissioner
Crenshaw withdrew her motion.

Reports

Chief Miller gave the August police activity report.

Commissioner Lauer advised the bid opening on Friday, September 11, 1987 for a dump box and snow plow was still being reviewed and would be awarded at the next meeting.

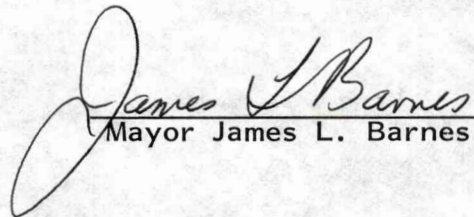

Adjournment

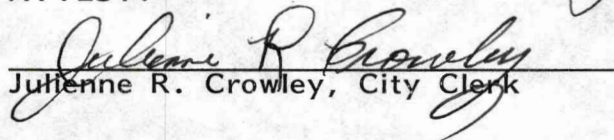
Said motion carried as follows: Ayes: Collins, Crenshaw, Lauer, Logan, Barnes. No nays.
