A Public Hearing was held for a zoning change for property located at 905 W Washington Street from R-2 Residential to Commercial. The property currently has a six unit apartment building, which will be torn down. The owner, Michael Hahn, has a purchase agreement with Casey's and supports the zoning change. Casey's General Store plans on purchasing the property to build a new building and add additional gas pumps. Ryan Swanson, of ARC Design, spoke on behalf of Casey's. No one spoke against. The public hearing was closed.
