He connected them with the school, maybe it could be stretched across the football field for a home game by students. I still need to check with Cork N Tap ref a trivia night.

Jeff Hallock shared some 250 swag that he purchased including a hat and banner from Amazon and a shirt from Dixon County Market. Conover. Mike Glenn shared that CMAAA has purchased some 250 banners to display on the building and on each side of the stage. John Lindhorst has purchased some flags and banners for the Music Garage.

Other discussions included a hot dog eating contest, watermelon seed spitting contest, drone show, bronze pouring and art tour, encourage local businesses to put on their own events.
